

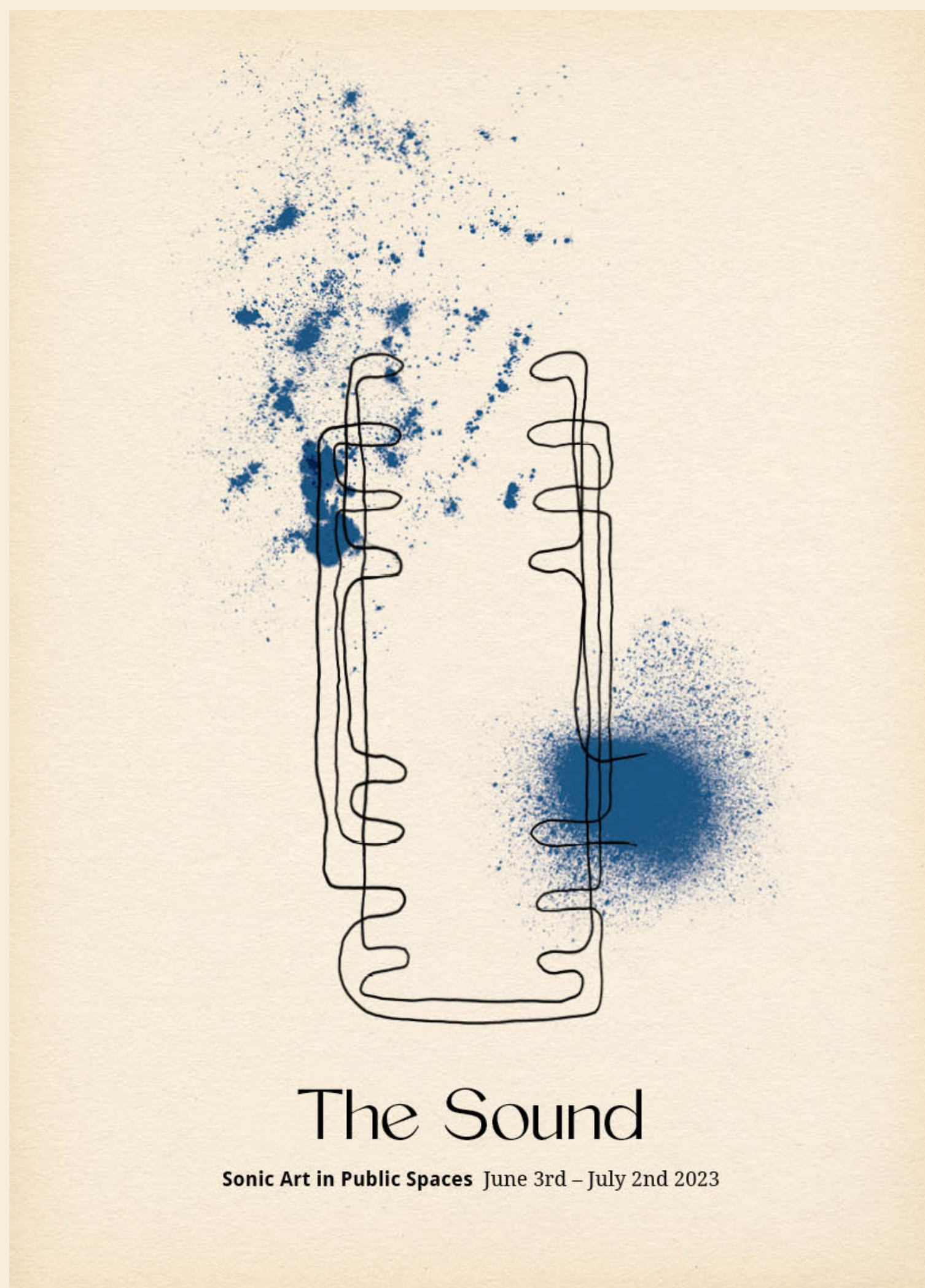

## New Sound Art Festival in Monheim am Rhein!

We are pleased to announce the start of the second Monheim Triennale. From *June 3 to July 2, 2023*, Monheim am Rhein will be the site of a new Sound Art Festival:

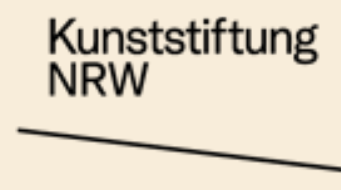
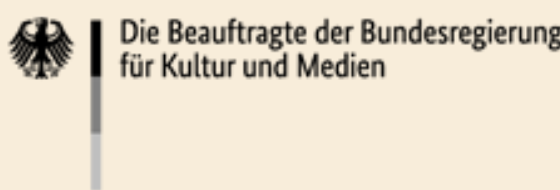
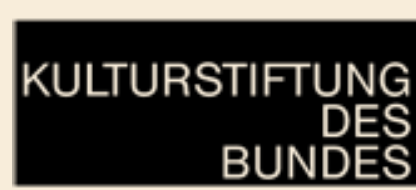
